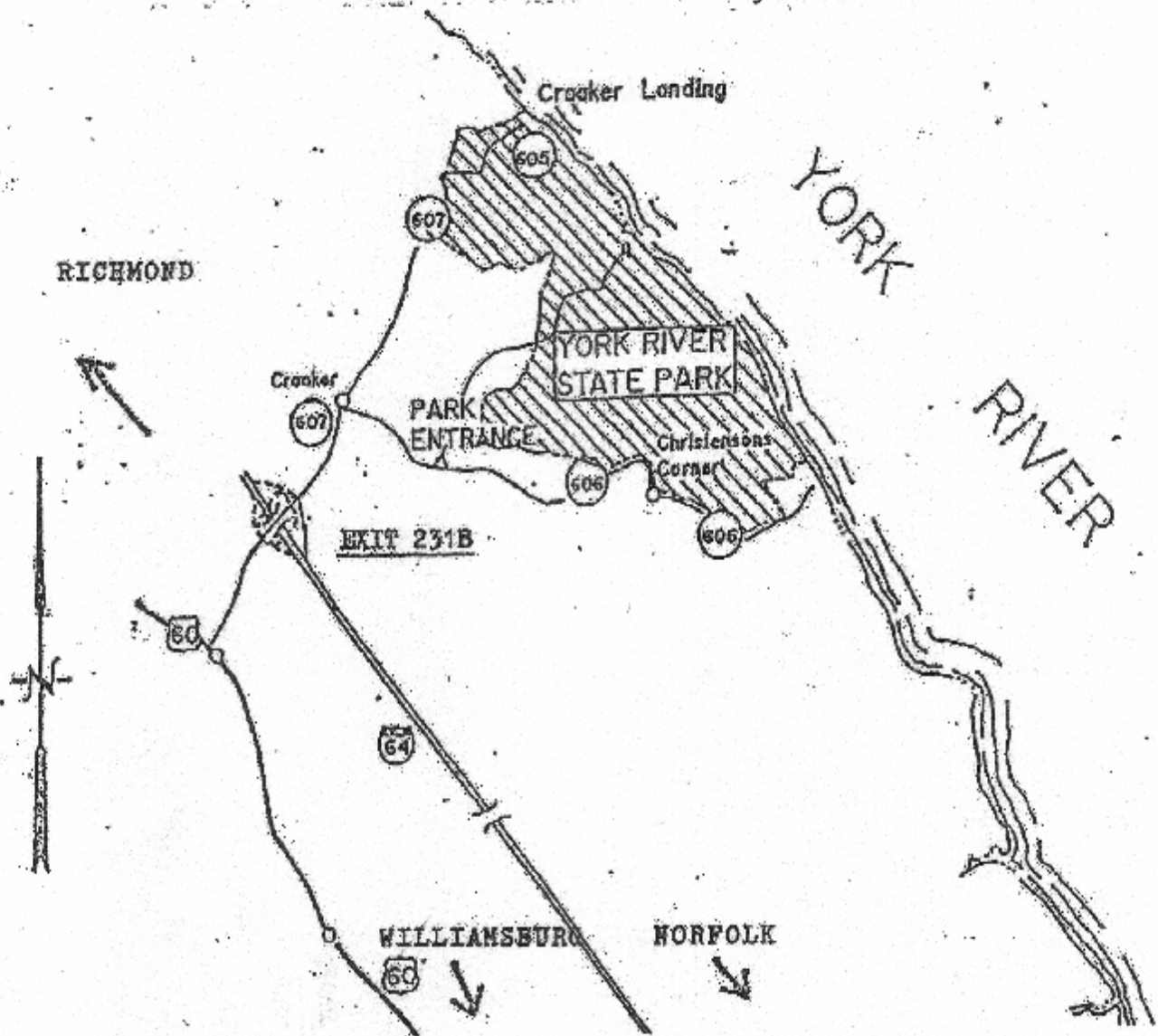


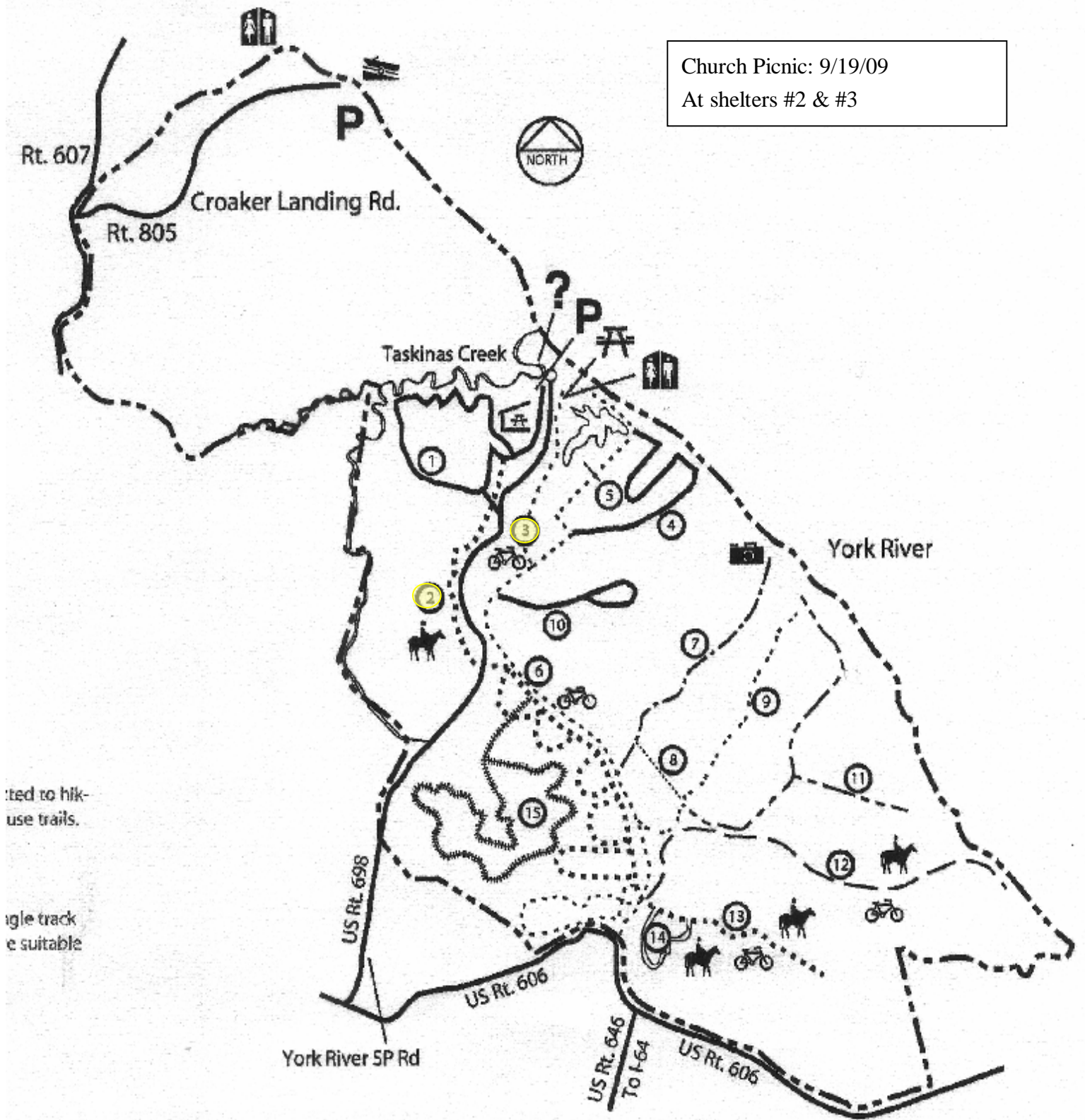
DIRECTIONS TO YORK RIVER STATE PARK



Take Exit 231-B (Croaker Exit) off of I 64, which is about 10 miles west of Williamsburg. This will put you onto Route 607, Croaker Road, heading north towards the York River. After approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile you will see Garrett's, a country store & gas station on the left. Just past this, make a right turn onto Route 606, Riverview Road. There will be a brown directional sign indicating you turn right for the Visitor Center (or go straight for the boat landing). Follow Riverview Road about 2 miles. You will see the park sign. Turn left onto York River Park Road and follow it down to the Visitor Center, which is where the picnic areas, trailheads, activities and the Park office are all centered. Park maps and information are available at the Visitor Center as well.
